

## **HEALING PART TWO:**

Before anyone begins to lay hands on the sick for healing or to cast out demons they must be born again in Christ Jesus and be filled with The Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit gives Christians the gifts as he chooses for them. Not all Christians are given the gift of healing so we must always ask The Lord to show us if we have the healing gift. God will reveal it to us in some small way or if he chooses to in a big way, we just have to take a step of faith and try it.

One thing to remember is that we must use the power and the authority that Jesus gave to his disciples and to us as well in the following scriptures.

### **John 14:13-14:**

13: And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, ~~~~~.

14: If ye shall ask anything in my name, I will do it.

There you have it; we must use the name of Jesus and be confident that He will answer our prayers and our commands for demons and sicknesses to come out of people, for he gave us the power and the authority over them and they must obey and submit to his name.

We must not ask The Lord to do it for us for God is our Father and he sees us as His mature children who are expected to use the Christ given power and the authority to command demons to go and for sicknesses to be healed in the name of Jesus just as we expect our children to use what they have learned so they can do for themselves.

Remember prayer is a form of asking God for something but the use of power and authority comes by the Holy Spirit when we ask for it in the name of Jesus.

We should always anoint our hands and foreheads with anointing oil and pray for God's protection upon us in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit before we enter into any healing session. If you do not then you could be open for an attack from our spiritual enemies of demonic origin. We found this to be true very quickly when we began to work in the healing ministry and failed to do it.

Some times it's important when a person wants to be healed that we ask them if they believe that God will give them what they are asking him for. They must have faith in God's healing power and you as the prayer warrier must also believe in the power and authority you were given by Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

**(King James) Scriptures to help you understand healing and to build up your faith to step out and do God's will for healing.**

**John 4:24:**

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

**John 5:19:**

Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. (Therefore we should do what Jesus did)

**John 9:31:**

Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

**John 10:27-30:**

27: My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

28: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

29: My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

30: I and my Father are one.

**John 14:12-15:**

12: Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13: And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14: If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

15: If ye love me, keep my commandments.

**Mathew 7:7-8:**

7: Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find, knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

8: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

**Mathew 10:1:**

1: And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

(We are also his disciples)

**Mathew 12:43-45:**

43: When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.

44: Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished.

45: Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

(This is why we must use caution when casting out demons and do it correctly by applying the blood of Jesus over the person).

**Mathew 18:18-20:**

18: Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

19: Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching (concerning) any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

20: For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

**Mark 1:8:**

(John preached)

8: I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

**Mark 5:25-34:**

25: And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

26: And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,

27: When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

28: For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

29: And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

30: And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?

31: And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?

32: And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing.

33: But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth.

34: And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

(Notice here who's faith was the key to healing.)

**Mark 11:22-24:**

22: And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

23: For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

24: Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

**Luke 8:43-48:**

43: And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

44: Came behind him, and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanchèd.

45: And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?

46: And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me.

47: And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately.

48: And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.

**Luke 11:9-10, 13:**

9: And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

10: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

13: If ye then, ~~~~~, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?
